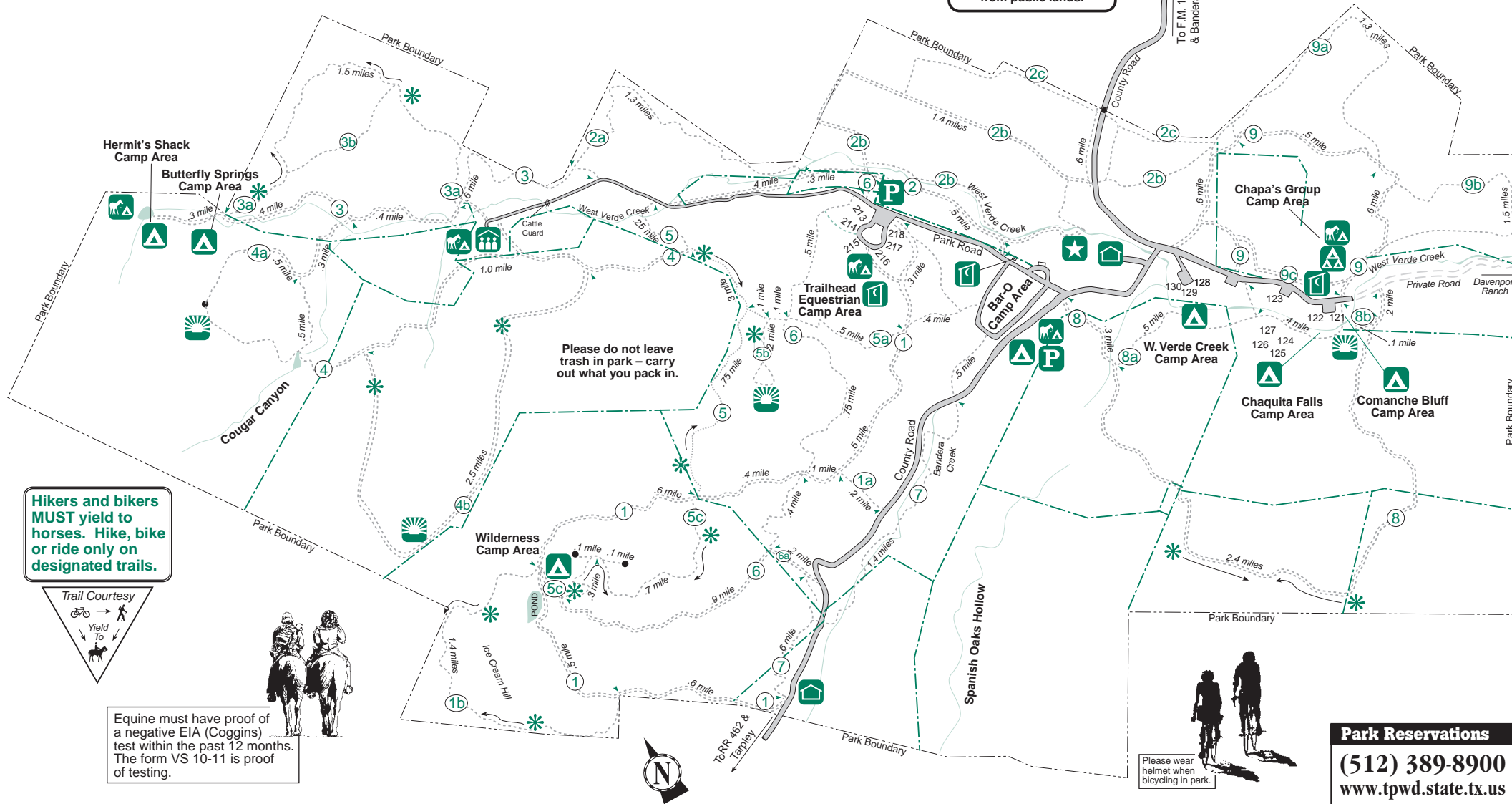

Hikers and bikers MUST yield to horses. Hike, bike or ride only on designated trails.



Equine must have proof of a negative EIA (Coggin's) test within the past 12 months. The form VS 10-11 is proof of testing.



Please wear helmet when bicycling in park.
